**Planned Giving Seminar at CSJ**

The College of St. Joseph and Chittenden Wealth Management Group are co-sponsoring a Planned Giving Seminar for professional financial advisors on Wednesday, September 26, 2007 in the St. Joseph Hall Conference Room on the CSJ campus. The half-day seminar (9 am to 12 pm) will be conducted by Jonathon Tidd, Esq. of West Simsbury, CT.

Tidd specializes in tax law with a focus on estate planning. He is a regular presenter for Planned Giving Group of New England and the National Conference on Planned Giving. His presentation will cover "income issues", recent IRS Pronouncements and current charitable giving planning issues including recent cases and rulings of significance. A portion of the seminar will deal with ethical considerations in charitable gift planning.

The conference is designed to benefit attorneys, accountants, trust officers, financial planners, development officers for non-profit organizations, and other financial professionals.
