Eligibility criteria

- A matriculated CSJ student in good academic standing
- Graduate and undergraduate student not Pell eligible must be enrolled at least half-time (**6 credits**)
- Continuing students must have a valid FAFSA for 2011-2012 and a 2012-2013 on file with the Financial Aid office. To complete the FAFSA go to www.fafsa.ed.gov. School code 003685.

Where does the aid come from

Financial aid is determined by identifying remaining eligibility from the 2011-2012 award year and eligibility toward the 2012-2013 award year. Student must be registered for at least **SIX** credits to be eligible for loans. Undergraduate students will be reviewed for Pell eligibility as well as loan eligibility. Enrollment changes must be reported to the Financial Aid Office immediately by the student. Financial Aid eligibility will be re-evaluated based on the new information.
